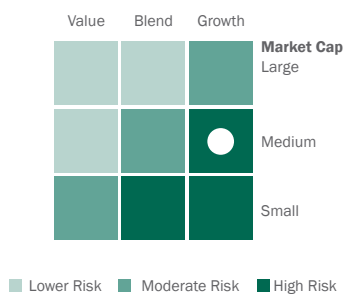

Philosophy

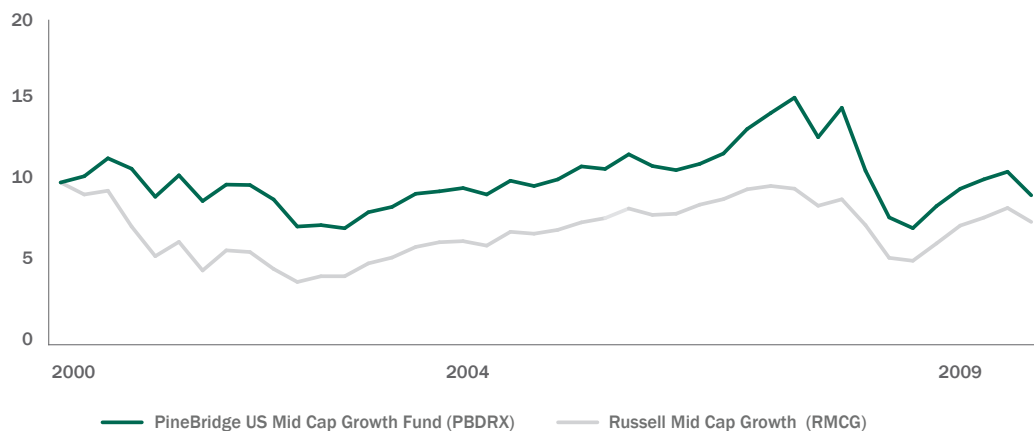
We believe the market is inefficient and our goal is to identify earnings growth in mid cap growth companies before it is reflected in the stock price.

We continuously and rigorously study company developments, including business strategy, management focus and financial results, to identify prospective companies.

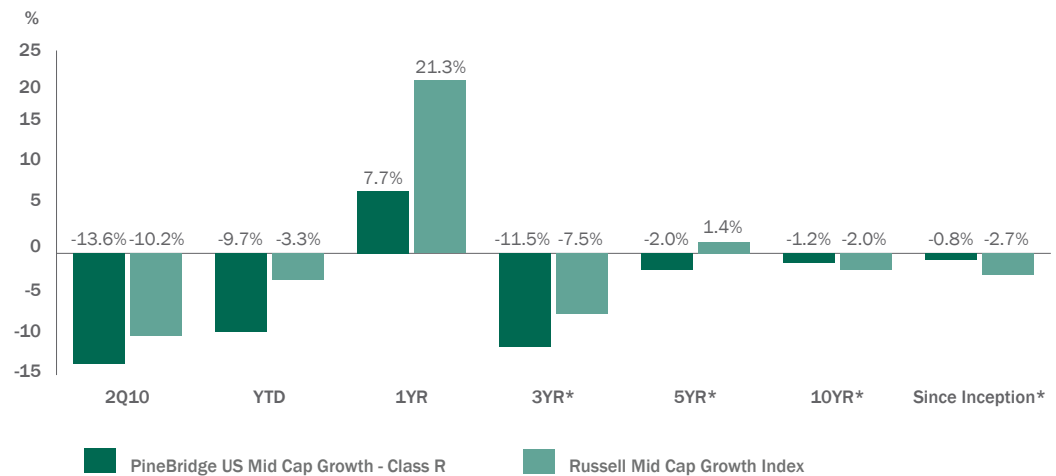

ROE - A measure of a corporation's profitability, calculated by dividing net income by total shareholder's equity.
